Today is the **29th day** of our Creator's **Seventh Lunar Month** count, in which the year begins in the spring. It is also the authentic **fourth lunar Sabbath of the month**. It looks like **07-29-5993**. It coincides with the Roman Gregorian calendar planetary date of *Thur., 11-14-2024*.

Our Creator placed His full moon beacon as the original New Moon and the start of His months, high above for all to see. All praise to YAHUAH Alahim for His steadfast love and compassion for His children and His patience in restoring His lost truths in preparation for the Second Coming of His Son, Yahusha haMashiach (the

Messiah). Simply because the full moon as New Moon, with its count to Lunar Sabbaths and annual Feast Days, is not popular among the Rabbinical Pharisee Jews or the Romanized Christian churches today, does in no way diminish its LIGHT OF TRUTH shining from the pages of Scripture and His Eternal Throne. TWO PRIESTS IN THE CLEANSING WATER

The teacher led me into the Chamber of Garments to show me the most intricate of clothing, a linen tunic, a breastplate of precious stones, finely woven colored fabrics, and a crown of gold. They were the garments of the high priest. Later on the same day I approached him with a question.

"When the covenant changes," I said, "there must also be a change of priesthood. So a new covenant must mean a new priesthood. But if there's a changing of the

priesthood, shouldn't there have been some sort of changing of the guard, a passing of the torch between the old and the new, a recognition...a transference...a blessing from the priesthood of Aaron to the priesthood of Messiah?"

"How could that have happened?" he asked. "The priesthood and the high priest at the time were corrupt and plotting His murder...But...what if there was someone...someone more of a high priest than Caiaphas, someone who represented the priesthood more than any other?"

"WHO?"

"The one called Yochanan (John) and known to the world as John the Baptist. He was the only priest in the history of the priesthood whose birth was announced by an angel in the sanctuary of the priests, the Temple, in the holy place during the priestly ministry. And what was the high priest's highest ministry? To cleanse the people of their sins. And what was John doing in the waters of the Jordan? Baptizing them for the cleansing of their sins. It was he who was the highest priest of Israel, the true representative of the Aaronic priesthood. So Messiah's ministry, His priesthood, must begin with John...the two priests, standing in the waters of the Jordan, the place of endings and beginnings, the two priesthoods, the priesthood of the old covenant and the priesthood of the new."

"That's it," I said. "That's the changing of the guard...the transference of the priesthood."

"And as the two high priests stand face-to-face, the old priesthood bears witness of the new. In the waters of the Jordan, Yochanan (John), bears witness of Messiah's ministry and declares it greater than his own. The blessing is spoken. The torch is passed. The cosmic changing of the guard is complete. And thus begins the priesthood of Messiah."

The Mission: The priesthood has been given to Messiah and to those who are His. Live this day as a priest of Yahuah Alahim. Minister His will and purposes. *Jeremiah 31:31-33; Matthew 3:13-16; Hebrews 7:11-17.*

Kerrie's Korner

It appears that Yahusha's baptism was that moment when the priesthood changed from that of Aaron and the Levitical priesthood to the long promised Messiah and His priesthood according to the order of Melchizedek.

Psa 110:4 The LORD has sworn And will not relent, "You *are* a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek."

Heb 5:6 As *He* also *says* in another place: "YOU ARE A PRIEST FOREVER ACCORDING TO THE ORDER OF MELCHIZEDEK";

Heb 5:10 called by God as High Priest "ACCORDING TO THE ORDER OF MELCHIZEDEK,"

Heb 6:20 where the forerunner has entered for us, *even* Jesus, having become High Priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.

Heb 7:11 Therefore, if perfection were through the Levitical priesthood (for under it the people received the law), what further need *was there* that another priest should rise according to the order of Melchizedek, and not be called according to the order of Aaron?

Heb 7:17 For He testifies: "YOU ARE A PRIEST FOREVER ACCORDING TO THE ORDER OF MELCHIZEDEK."

Heb 7:21 (for they have become priests without an oath, but He with an oath by Him who said to Him: "THE LORD HAS SWORN AND WILL NOT RELENT,

'YOU ARE A PRIEST FOREVER ACCORDING TO THE ORDER OF MELCHIZEDEK' "),

The Earthly Tabernacle and Priesthood

Heb 9:1 Then indeed, even the first *covenant* had ordinances of divine service and the earthly sanctuary.

Heb 9:2 For a tabernacle was prepared: the first *part*, in which *was* the lampstand, the table, and the showbread, which is called the sanctuary;

Heb 9:3 and behind the second veil, the part of the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of All,

Heb 9:4 which had the golden censer and the ark of the covenant overlaid on all sides with gold, in which *were* the golden pot that had the manna, Aaron's rod that budded, and the tablets of the covenant;

Heb 9:5 and above it were the cherubim of glory overshadowing the mercy seat. Of these things we cannot now speak in detail.

Heb 9:6 Now when these things had been thus prepared, the priests always went into the first part of the tabernacle, performing *the services*.

Heb 9:7 But into the second part the high priest *went* alone once a year, not without blood, which he offered for himself and *for* the people's sins *committed* in ignorance;

Heb 9:8 the Ruach haKadosh indicating this, that the way into the Holiest of All was not yet made manifest while the first tabernacle was still standing.

Heb 9:9 It *was* symbolic for the present time in which both gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot make him who performed the service perfect in regard to the conscience—

Heb 9:10 concerned only with foods and drinks, various washings, and fleshly ordinances imposed until the time of reformation.

Redemption through the Blood of Messiah unto the Heavens

Heb 9:11 But Messiah came *as* High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation.

Heb 9:12 Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with **His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.**

Heb 9:13 For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh,

Heb 9:14 how much more shall the blood of Messiah, who through the eternal Ruach offered Himself without spot to YAHUAH, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living Alahim (God)?

Heb 9:15 And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.

Heb 9:16 For where there *is* a testament, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator.

Heb 9:17 For a testament *is* in force after men are dead, since it has no power at all while the testator lives.

Heb 9:18 Therefore not even the first *covenant* was dedicated without blood.

Heb 9:19 For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and goats, with water, scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book itself and all the people,

Heb 9:20 saying, "THIS IS THE BLOOD OF THE COVENANT WHICH YAHUAH ALAHIM HAS COMMANDED YOU."

Heb 9:21 Then likewise he sprinkled with blood both the tabernacle and all the vessels of the ministry.

Heb 9:22 And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission.

Heb 9:23 Therefore *it was* necessary that the copies of the things in the heavens should be purified with these, but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these.

Heb 9:24 For Messiah has not entered the holy places made with hands, *which are* copies of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of YAHUAH Alahim for us;

Heb 9:25 not that He should offer Himself often, as the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood of another—

Heb 9:26 He then would have had to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now, once at the end of the ages, He has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself.

Heb 9:27 And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment,

Heb 9:28 so Messiah was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.

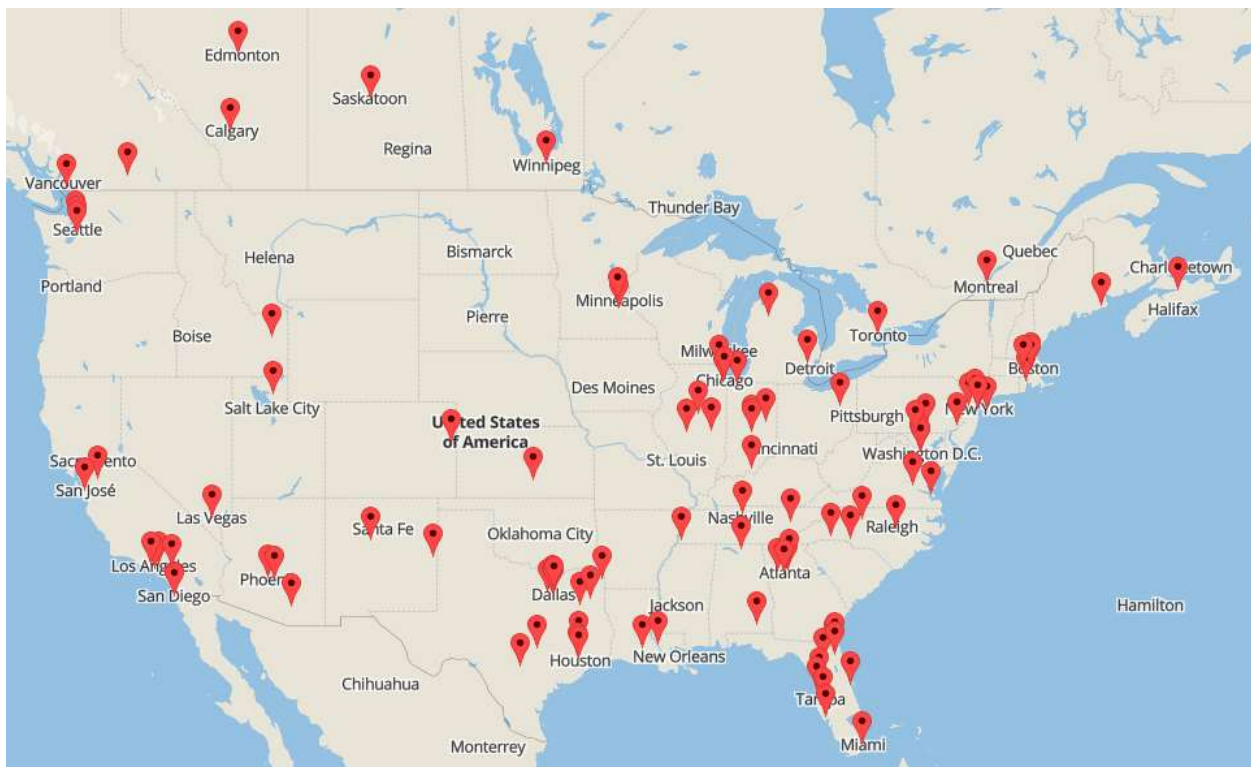

KEY DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE MELCHIZEDEK AND LEVITICAL PRIESTHOODS

- Perfection is found in the Melchizedek priesthood, but not in the priesthood of Levi. (Hebrews 7:11)
- Melchizedek is greater than Levi. (Hebrews 7:7)
- The Melchizedek priesthood needs only the blood of the Messiah, and not animal sacrifice. (Hebrews 10:11-12)
- Melchizedek is forever but the Levitical priesthood was only for a time. (Hebrews 9:10)
- The Levitical priesthood system is a copy and shadow of the heavenly Melchizedek priesthood. (Hebrews 8:5)
- It is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sin, but the Messiah saves completely through his priesthood. (Hebrews 10:4, 7:25)
- Levitical sacrifices had to be offered up day by day, but the Messiah's offering of his blood under the Melchizedek priesthood was once and for all. (Hebrews 7:27)

Order Of Malkitsedeq

(1 Kephah 2:9) But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a set-apart nation, a people for a possession, that you should proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvellous light,

(Debarim 7:6) “For you are a set-apart people to Yahuah your Elohim. Yahuah your Elohim has chosen you to be a people for Himself, a treasured possession above all the peoples on the face of the earth.

Praise Be Yah

(Ibrim 7:14-17) 14 For it is perfectly clear that our Master arose from Yehudah, a tribe about which Mosheh never spoke of concerning priesthood, 15 and this is clearer still, if another priest arises in the likeness of Malkitsedeq, 16 who has become, not according to the torah of fleshly command, but according to the power of an endless life, 17 for He does witness, “You are a priest forever according to the order of Malkitsedeq.”
