Today is the **22<sup>nd</sup> day** of our Creator's **Eighth Lunar Month** count, in which the year begins in the spring. It is also the authentic **third lunar Sabbath of the month**. It looks like **08-22-5993**. It coincides with the Roman Gregorian calendar planetary date of *Sat., 12-07-2024*.

Our Creator placed His full moon beacon as the original New Moon and the start of His months, high above for all to see. All praise to YAHUAH Alahim for His steadfast love and compassion for His children and His patience in restoring His lost truths in preparation for the Second Coming of His Son, Yahusha haMashiach (the Messiah). Simply because the full moon as New Moon, with its count to Lunar Sabbaths and annual Feast Days, is not popular among the Rabbinical Pharisee Jews or the Romanized Christian churches today, does in no way diminish its LIGHT OF

TRUTH shining from the pages of Scripture and His Eternal Throne. Only YAHUAH'S Ruach (power, presence, and provision) gives those who seek Him with all their hearts *"eyes to see and ears to hear."* Ask Him today to reveal His New Moon and lunar Sabbath to you and see how your life will change as your soul temple is synchronized to His for all eternity.

## **The Waiting Game**

"Yahuah is my light and my salvation, so why should I be afraid? Yahuah is my fortress, protecting me from danger, so why should I tremble? When evil people come to devour me, when my enemies and foes attack me, they will stumble and fall. Though a might army surrounds me, my heart will not be afraid. Even if I am attacked, I will remain confident. The one thing I ask of Yahuah, the thing I seek most, is to live in the house of Yahuah all the days of my life, delighting in Yahuah's perfection and meditating in His temple. For He will conceal me there when troubles come; He will hide me in His sanctuary. He will place me out of reach on a high rock. Then I will hold my head

high above my enemies who surround me. At His sanctuary I will offer sacrifices with shouts of joy, singing and praising Yahuah with music.”

*Psalms 24:1-6*

Waiting can feel like torture when you're afraid. David wrote Psalm 27 at a time when he was terribly afraid, but he didn't panic. Instead, he called upon Yahuah and pleaded his case before Him. Then he waited patiently for Yahuah to rescue him. Any scared person knows that fear can cause people to make hasty, unwise decisions, and cause them to act before they're ready. Fear can make people impatient and reckless. As you read this Psalm, learn from David's example about taking your fears to Yahuah Alahim.

The three other Psalms in this reading also have something to say about times of fear: When you're afraid of losing your honor (Psalm 25); Your reputation (Psalm 26); Or even your life (Psalm 28).

David's men wanted him to kill Saul. David knew that it was not his job. But the fulfillment of Yahuah Alahim's promise would come about in His own timing. So David placed his trust in Yahuah Alahim and waited for Yahuah, despite his fear (Psalm 27:14). As it turns out David had to wait fourteen years before being crowned king.

Waiting for Yahuah takes effort. It may seem as though He has refused to answer our prayers or doesn't feel the urgency of our situation. But He knows much more than we do.

Lamentations 3:24-26 urges us to hope and wait for Yahuah because often He uses waiting to refresh, renew and teach us.

David trusted Yahuah Alahim to do what was right.

**Lesson:** Trust in Yahuah's timing and make use of our times of waiting by discovering what He may be trying to teach us. Psalm 25:1 – Psalm 28:9.


## **Kerrie's Korner - Short Story**

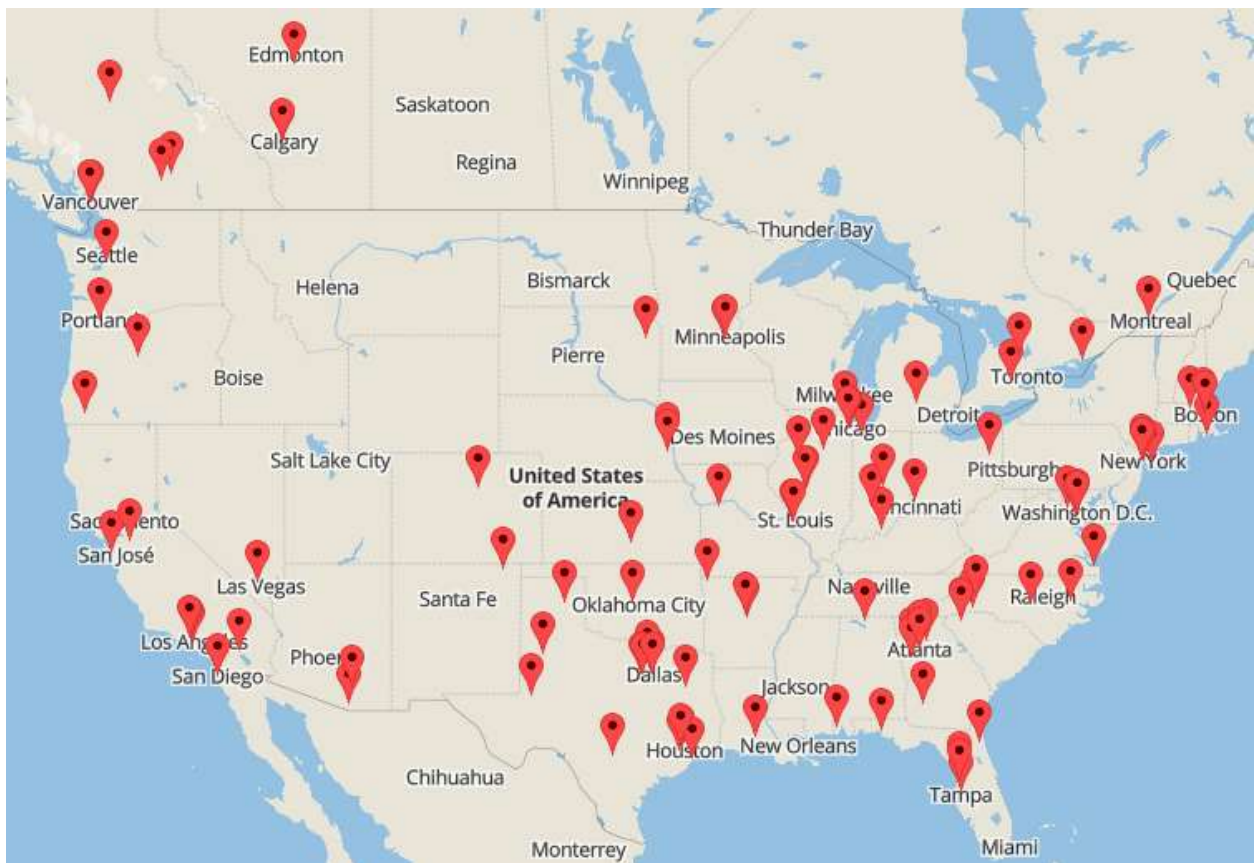

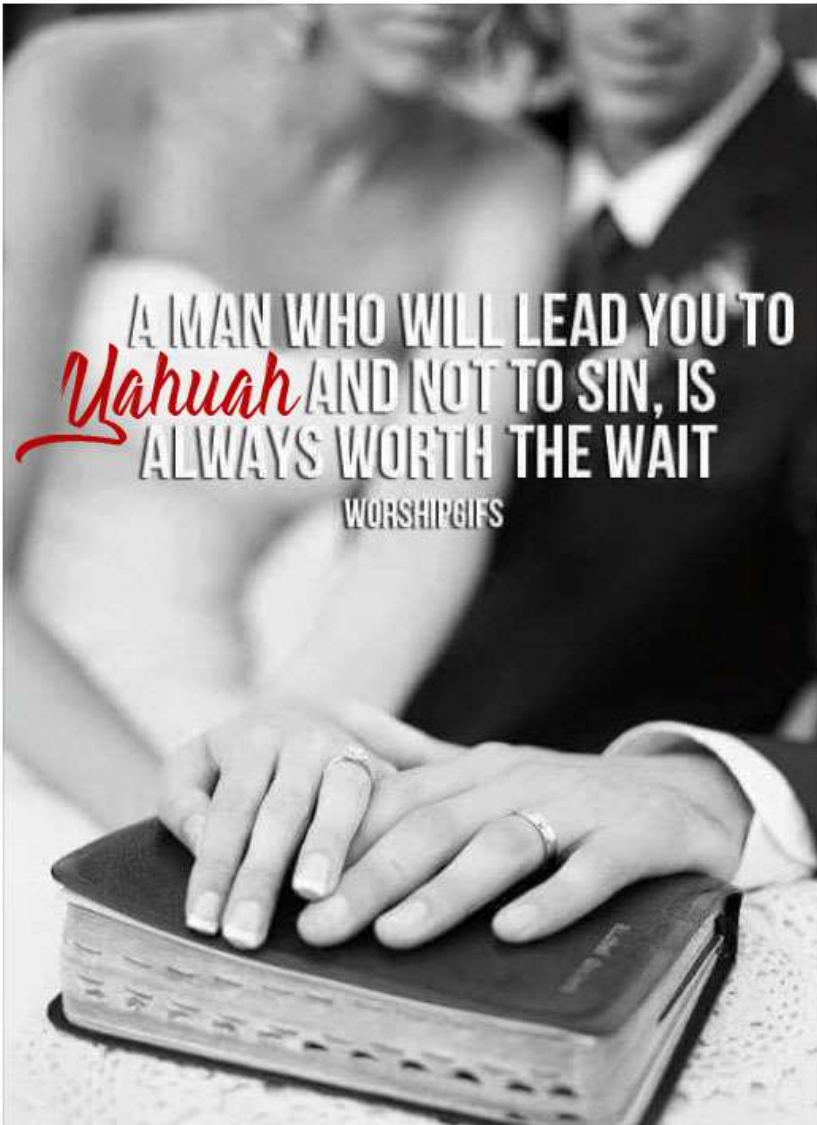

**but I trust you.**


I don't see a way, but I know
